## Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring tool that will be administered three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your student will participate in the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Reading/Mathematics assessments. Please refer to the district assessment calendar for specific testing dates for each grade level. Your student's results from PM1 and PM2 are for informational purposes only, and you can access the results via Skyward Family Access after testing is complete.

FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get easier or more difficult depending on how the student responds, and each student will see different questions from a common item bank. Each test attempt (PM1, PM2, and PM3) will present 35–40 items that will cover the entire test "blueprint," meaning students will encounter items representative of the standards within the subject or grade level.
