**IMPORTANT\*\*\*Please complete Emergency Medical Contact Information form.  
We need to have working phone numbers on file in the Clinic to better serve your student.**

### **School Clinic Visits:**

General complaints will be given approximately 10 minutes rest after assessment is completed.

Requirement for immediate pick-up from school:

- Temperature greater than 100 degrees\*\*Students must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication to reduce fever before returning to school.
- Vomiting or suspicious/possible contagious illness
- School nurse verbally states your student needs to be picked up and cannot be at school.

### **All Medications: (Prescription AND over-the-counter) *that cannot be given at home:***

- MUST BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL BY PARENT/GUARDIAN/ADULT
- MUST have a Medication Administration Permission Form completed with parent/guardian and physician signatures (Form is located on district website under Health Services)
- MUST BE IN THE ORIGINAL CONTAINER.
- MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR by a parent/guardian or it *will be destroyed*.
- MUST BE KEPT IN THE CLINIC unless a physician's order is on file stating otherwise.

**Health Screenings:** Health screenings are available to all students at the request of a teacher or parent.

Health screenings are provided according to Department of Health and Department of Education guidelines:

- Kindergarten – Vision & Hearing
- 1<sup>st</sup> Grade – Vision & Hearing, Height & Weight, Body Mass Index (BMI)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade – Vision, Height & Weight, Body Mass Index (BMI)

**\*\*If you do not want your student to participate in screenings, a signed note must be sent to the School Clinic immediately or noted on the Emergency Medical Information Form.**

***Screenings begin within the first few days of school.***

**Special Health Problems:** The school nurse will develop an Individual Health Care Plan and Emergency Action Plan for students with chronic health problems and special needs. Parents need to call clinic staff of a student's health problems or special needs. Parent participation is critical.

**Head Lice & Nits:** *Lafayette County School Board's policy is a no nit/head lice policy.* Your student must be picked up if found to have head lice or nits by clinic staff. Your student must brought to the clinic to be cleared/rechecked by clinic staff before returning to the classroom.
