a brief discussion, the Imagine Learning (previously Edgenuity) Background Check Agreement was unanimously approved following a motion by Mr. Jeff Walker and a second by Mrs. Kimberly Adams.

4.03 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES NORTH FLORIDA COLLEGE DUAL ENROLLMENT ARTICULATION

AGREEMENT – Superintendent Edwards explained that most changes in this agreement were made to reflect updated legislative requirements. The North Florida College Dual Enrollment Articulation Agreement for the 2026-2027 school year was unanimously approved following a motion by Mr. Jeff Walker and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray.

4.04 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES FLORIDA GATEWAY COLLEGE AFFILIATION AGREEMENT – The 2026

Affiliation Agreement with Florida Gateway College for Interning Teaching Professionals was unanimously approved following a motion by Mrs. Kimberly Adams and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray.

4.05 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES NEFEC ESOL ENDORSEMENT ADD-ON PROGRAM – Following

discussion, the NEFEC ESOL Endorsement Add-On Program for 2026-2031 was unanimously approved following a motion by Mrs. Marion McCray and a second by Mrs. Kimberly Adams.

4.06 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES SREF REPORTS – Mr. Scott Sadler, Director of Support Services explained

the findings and the actions taken to correct noted issues. The 2025-2026 State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF) Reports were unanimously approved following a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray.

4.07 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES ECTAC AGREEMENT – Superintendent Edwards explained the

agreement previously approved by the Board was a draft, and that this represented the final agreement. The 2026-2027 East Coast Technical Assistance Center (ECTAC) Agreement was unanimously approved following a motion by Mrs. Marion McCray and a second by Mr. Jeff Walker.

4.08 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH POSITIVE BEHAVIOR SUPPORTS

CORP – The Contract for Services Agreement with Positive Behavior Supports Corp. that was provided was

not appropriately dated. Following discussion, the agreement was unanimously approved pending correction of the dates for the upcoming fiscal year (July 1, 2026-June 30,2027), on a motion by Mr. Jeff Walker and a second by Mrs. Kimberly Adams.

4.09 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES SCHOOL START TIME COMPLIANCE REPORT – Superintendent

Edwards explained that the data gathered during the District's year-long evaluation of school start time changes, including feedback from public hearings, had been compiled into the compliance form provided by the Florida Department of Education. He noted that the District is required to submit this report by June 1, 2026. The 2026-2027 School Start Time Compliance Report was unanimously approved on a motion by Mrs. Kimberly Adams and a second by Mr. Taylor McGrew. (Form SST-1 on file in District Office)

4.10 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES CAREERSOURCE NORTH FLORIDA AGREEMENT – The CareerSource

North Florida Internship Worksite Agreement was unanimously approved following a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray.

4.11 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES LEGAL SERVICES CONTRACT – The contract with Leenette McMillan for
