

## ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

Home schooled students may participate in the official testing that our district administers to public school students.

Students must have passing scores on Grade 10 FSA ELA and on End of Course Exams (exact subjects vary based on the year your child begins 9<sup>th</sup> grade) if he/she plans to receive a Florida diploma.

The assessment schedule is posted on the district website, <http://lafayette.schooldesk.net>. Note that this schedule is subject to change. Testing schedule changes will also be posted on our district website. Please contact the Testing Coordinator of the school at your child's level (Mrs. Lisa Newman, Elementary: 294-4116 or Mrs. Becky Sharpe: Middle & High—294-1417) to make arrangements for your child to test. Be sure to contact us at least four weeks prior to the scheduled test so we will have materials prepared for your child.
