MINUTES LAFAYETTE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD REGULAR MEETING, JANUARY 16, 2018

The Lafayette County School Board convened in regular session, Tuesday, January 16, 2018 beginning at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mr. Robert Edwards, Superintendent of Schools; Mrs. Marion McCray, Vice-Chair; Mr. Darren Driver, Member; Mr. Jeff Walker, Member; Mr. Taylor McGrew, Member; and Ms. Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, School Board Attorney. Mrs. Amanda Hickman, Chairperson, was absent. Administrators present were Gina Hart, Director of Teaching and Learning Services; Tammi Maund, Director of Finance; Stewart Hancock, LHS Principal; and Stephen Clark, LES Principal.

CALL TO ORDER

Acting Chair, Marion McCray, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Taylor McGrew gave the invocation and Superintendent Robert Edwards led the Pledge to the Flag.
