CALL TO ORDER

Mrs. Amanda Hickman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Darren Driver gave the

- 4.05 CODE OF CONDUCT RELATING TO NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH & BREAKFAST PROGRAMS Following discussion, Mr. Taylor McGrew moved to approve the written Code of Conduct which shall govern the performance and actions of Lafayette District officers, School Board members, employees, directors, volunteers or agents who are engaged in any aspect of procurement, contracts, grants or the administration and supervision of contracts supported entirely or in part by federal entitlement funds disbursed by USDA. McCray seconded the motion. The vote for approval was unanimous. (Code of Conduct on file in district office)

- 4.06 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES PROCUREMENT STATEMENT On a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mr. Jeff Walker, the School Board unanimously approved the Procurement Policy Statement for Lafayette District Schools. The procurement policy statement shall govern all purchasing activities that relate to any aspect of the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs.
