JOB DESCRIPTION

QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) Bachelor's degree from an accredited educational institution.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of current research in regard to the effective operation of a modern media center. Ability to organize and operate a media center that is the information center for the school and a center for life-long learning. Ability to communicate well in both written and oral forms with students, peers, administrators, and others. Knowledge and skill in the use and care of audiovisual equipment, computers and other current technologies. Ability to select, organize, maintain and catalog a wide variety of print materials. Knowledge of and skill in the use of a variety of computer software. Ability to select appropriate types and levels of materials for instructional and recreational purposes. Ability to manage the budget for the Media Center as assigned.

IOB GOAL

To facilitate the teaching and learning processes by providing an environment in which a variety of media is effectively utilized in an atmosphere which promotes inquiry, creativity, self-direction and communication of information and ideas.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Planning/Preparation

- *(1) Develop long and short range goals and objectives for the media program based on student, faculty, and curriculum needs.
- *(2) Plan with teachers and instructional leaders to develop curriculum and integrate media/information skills into the school program.
- *(3) Develop schedules and organize resources to allow easy access to information and services.
- *(4) Select library and other instructional support materials to enhance learning consistent with the needs of students with diverse cultural and social-economic backgrounds, learning styles, and special needs.
- *(5) Review the School Improvement Plan, search out and plan for the procurement of materials necessary to support the media needs of students and staff.

MEDIA SPECIALIST (Continued)

- *(6) Participate in the preparation for changing curriculum and continuous improvement requirements.
- *(7) Manages long distance learning labs.

Classroom Management

- *(8) Develop and implement policies and procedures necessary for the efficient and effective operation of the media center.
- *(9) Prepare, submit, and administer media center budget based on program goals and objectives.
- *(10) Create an inviting, attractive, safe atmosphere conducive to learning.
- *(11) Maintain complete and accurate records as required by law, District policy, and administrative regulations.
- *(12) Instruct, assign, and supervise support staff and volunteers.
- *(13) Coordinate the selection and acquisition process for media resources and equipment.
- *(14) Provide for the use, maintenance, repair, and inventory of all media center materials and equipment.
- *(15) Ensure accessibility to resources.
- *(16) Provide for use of current technologies.
- *(17) Manage student conduct in a positive manner.
- *(18) Establish an operating environment which inviting, stimulating and contemporary.

Assessment/Evaluation

- *(19) Evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of the media program.
- *(20) Use evaluation results to improve media services.
- *(21) Assist with responsibilities for school testing program by proctoring and scheduling space.
- *(22) Handle all test materials in a confidential and secure manner.
- *(23) Solicit ongoing feed back from members of the school staff regarding the availability, use and impact of media instructional support materials.
- *(24) Develop a system of records which provide an appropriate database for evaluating the use and distribution of the media collection and supporting materials.
- *(25) Provide feedback to classroom teachers regarding students and their media center habits with the intent of providing additional evidence of student growth and developmental needs.

Intervention/Direct Services

- *(26) Teach library media skills in collaboration with teachers to support classroom instruction.
- *(27) Provide instruction in use of resources, services and equipment.
- *(28) Encourage and train faculty to incorporate library media resources into curriculum.
- *(29) Provide reference assistance.
- *(30) Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of a broad curriculum base.
- *(31) Apply principles of learning and effective teaching in instructional delivery.
- *(32) Use a variety of instructional strategies appropriate for teaching students from diverse backgrounds with different learning styles and special needs.
- *(33) Use appropriate techniques and strategies to enhance the application of critical, creative and evaluative thinking capabilities of students.
- *(34) Use appropriate materials, technology, and resources to help meet learning needs of all students.

- *(35) Provide a positive environment in which students are encouraged to be actively engaged in the learning process.
- *(36) Provide instruction on safety procedures and proper handling of materials and equipment.
- *(37) Recognize overt indicators of student distress or abuse and take appropriate intervention, referral or reporting actions.

Technology

- *(38) Use technology resources effectively.
- *(39) Use appropriate technology in instructional delivery.
- *(40) Use technology to establish an atmosphere of active learning.
- *(41) Provide students with opportunities to use technology to gather and share information with others.
- *(42) Facilitate student access to the use of electronic resources.
