CHAPTER 8.00 - AUXILIARY SERVICES

COMPETITIVE SALES

8.235

- I. All vending machines installed on school premises that are not operated by the food service program must have School Board approval. Vending machines shall not be operated in competition with the school breakfast or lunch programs. Items in vending machines shall meet the criteria established in Policy 2.20, Wellness Program.
- II. Concession sales operated by the student body association or by other school agency during normal school hours must have advance authorization from the Superintendent. The concession sales shall not be operated in competition with the school breakfast or lunch programs.
- III. With the exception of the food service program, the Lafayette County School Board prohibits the sale of all foods and beverages including carbonated beverages and other minimal nutritional foods as well as nutritious foods during the breakfast and lunch periods at any location that is accessible to students during the meal periods.
- IV. Beginning one hour after the close of the last lunch period, the sale of food and beverage items is permitted by school organizations at secondary schools only.
- V. Food and beverages for class activities such as field trips, incentives, and parties shall be coordinated with the food service manager of the school site at least two (2) weeks prior to the activity to ensure there is no competition with the food service program.
