

Title I Program:

Supplemental Educational Services (SES)

SES was available through school year 2012-13.

The program consisted of outside providers who were hired using Supplemental Academic Instructional funds for Title I tutoring services for eligible students. Lafayette Elementary School students who scored Level 1 or Level 2 on FCAT Reading or Math were eligible for these services. After-school SES services are no longer available as of the 2013-14 school year. However, RtI services are being provided during the school day.
