Dear Parent or Guardian:

The virtual options provided by Lafayette County Schools during the academic year are MyDistrict Virtual School and Edgenuity.

For self-motivated students who know how to organize their time and see tasks through to completion, a virtual school course may be a good fit. Parents of virtual school students must be prepared to commit to a schedule of montly phone calls with the virtual school teacher in order to review academic progress.

For the 2017-2018 school year, open enrollment begins May 12, 2017 and the deadline to register for a MyDistrict Virtual course and/or Edgenuity course during the school day **is July 11, 2017**.

Full-Time and Part-Time Elementary Virtual Applications - 2017-2018 school year:

The initial enrollment period for K12/Fuel Education and Calvert Education Services will begin on May 12, 2017 and end on July 11, 2017. A second enrollment period will begin on July 12 and end on September 20, 2017.

Full-Time and Part Time Secondary Virtual Applications - Semester 1 for the 2017-2018 school year:

The initial enrollment period for MyDistrict Virtual School courses (Grades 6-12) will begin on May 12, 2017 and close on July 11, 2017. A second enrollment period will begin on July 12 and end on September 20, 2017.

Full-Time and Part Time Secondary Virtual Applications - Semester 2 for the 2017-2018 school year:

A final enrollment period for MyDistrict Virtual School courses (Grades 6-12) will begin on December 4, 2017 and end on February 2, 2018.

The following steps are necessary to enroll in a MyDistrict Virtual School or Edgenuity course:

- 1. The parent/student meets with their counselor to discuss the course of interest and to determine if it is appropriate for the student.
- 2. If choosing MyDistrict, visit the MyDistrict website to view courses available for the 2017-2018 school year http://www2.nefec.org/virtual/. If choosing Edgenuity, contact the District Virtual Coordinator (Becky Sharpe: bsharpe@lcsbmail.net for a list of courses.)
- The parent/student must create an account and register for MyDistrict Virtual School or Edgenuity. Register for MyDistrict through www.flvs.net. Be sure to choose *My District Virtual School* when registering for your course. Register for Edgenuity through www.edgenuity.com/IS-Login. Follow the directions given to you by your school counselor or Virtual School Coordinator.
- 4. The Virtual School Coordinator or Counselor approves course(s).
- 5. MyDistrict Virtual School or Edgenuity will assign a teacher and this may take up to two weeks depending upon course/teacher availability.

Taking a MyDistrict Virtual School course or Edgenuity course during the regular scheduled school day:

- Students have the option to take a My District Virtual School or Edgenuity course as one of their six courses each school year.
- Open Enrollment for a MyDistrict and Edgenuity begins May 12, 2017.
- This option is only available if the student has signed up for the course 30 days BEFORE the first day of school (deadline is July 11, 2017).

MyDistrict Virtual School courses are also available to take outside of the regular school day. See your School Counselor or Virtual School Coordinator if you are interested in this option.

For the 2017-2018 school year, the deadline to register for a MyDistrict Virtual or Edgenuity course during the school day is July 11, 2017.
